TASTING NOTES | Our 2011 Sonoma County Merlot has inviting aromas of dark fruit and spice which translate well at first sip. Experience black raspberry, ripe plum and anise flavors that linger on the tongue as its velvety tannins come from behind to give this merlot a smooth, polished finish.

WINEMAKING | Handpicked fruit for this Merlot came from mountain, hillside, benchland and valley floor vineyard sites from Sonoma County's Alexander Valley to the Carneros

regions. Careful site selection ensures that only the best-suited and finest quality fruit are captured in every bottle of our Sonoma County Merlot.

VINTAGE | 2011 was a very cool growing season, with late precipitation in June. Around mid-summer heavy rains came and allowed vines to increase vigor -creating lush full canopies. Long hang times allowed the fruit to develop evenly and created complex flavors and aromas.
